



FITTING GUIDE


1. Disassemble the dash and remove the three (3) climate control knobs and two (2) Phillips screws from behind



2. Using a panel removal tool, unsnap and remove the radio/climate control panel




3. Remove the fresh air and circulation stickers from the factory panel and place them in the appropriate locations in the kit



4. Remove the hazard button and AC/defrost buttons from the factory panel, and install them onto the kit


FITTING GUIDE

5. Snap the Double DIN brackets to the inside edge of the Double DIN trim plate



6. Slide the Double DIN head unit into the bracket/radio housing assembly (from behind) and secure the head unit to the assembly using the screws supplied with the radio

7. Snap the Double DIN trim plate into the radio housing



8. Make all connections to the radio and reassemble dashboard in reverse order of disassembly to complete your installation
