Thank you for purchasing this product. Please read through these operating instructions so you will know how to operate your model properly. After you've finished reading the instructions, keep this manual in a safe place for future reference.

Only connect the unit to a 12-volt power supply with negative grounding.



Never install this unit where the operation & condition for safe driving is impaired.



Never use the video display function in the front when driving to prevent the violation of laws & regulations and also to reduce the risk of traffic accident except for using rear view video camera. Please don't change the fuse on the power cord without professional guidance, using improper fuse may cause damage to this unit or even cause fire.



Please contact your nearest dealer if one of the following symptoms is experienced:



- (a). Water or other objects enters the unit.
- (b). There is smoke.
- (c). Peculiar smell.

To ensure safe driving, please adjust the volume to a safe and comfortable level in case of emergency situations.



Never expose this unit, amplifier, and speakers to moisture or water to prevent electric sparks or fire.



Safety Precautions

- 1. Never disassemble or adjust the unit without any professional guidance. For details, please consult any professional car shop / dealer for inquiry.
- If the front panel or TFT monitor is dirty, please use a clean silicone cloth and neutral detergent to wipe off the spot. Using a rough cloth and non-neutral detergent such as alcohol for cleaning may result in scratching or decoloration to the monitor.
- 3. If any abnormal behavior of the unit is found, please refer to trouble shooting guide of this manual. If no relevant information is found, please press the [RESET] key on the front panel to resume factory default.
- 4. If you have parked the car in hot or cold weather for a long time, please wait until the temperature in the car becomes normal before operating the unit.
- 5. Using the car heater in low temperature environment may result in moisture inside the unit, DO NOT use the unit in this situation. Eject the disc and wipe off the moisture on the disc. If the unit still doesn't work after a few hours, please contact the service center.
- 6. Do not impact the LCD monitor which could cause damage.
- 7. To prevent damage to the screen, avoid touching it with sharp objects.
- 8. To provide a clear demonstration and an alternative for easy understanding to the operation of this unit, graphic illustrations are used.
- However, some illustrations are different from the actual images displayed on the screen.
- 9. Operate the unit correctly according to this manual to prevent unnecessary problem. The guarantee won't be valid if the problem is caused by inappropriate operation.

Warning

Detect parking brake

- In order to be able to install the android application, the handbrake connection must be connected. Engage the parking brake for APP installation.
- Connect the cable "BRAKE" to the parking brake switch to view video files on the TFT monitor. Engage the parking brake for viewing videos.
- When the parking brake is not engaged, the monitor displays "Warning!!!, Video playback is disabled for your safety. Engage parking brake to watch video.", preventing the driver to watch content while driving. The rear screens are not interested in this inhibition.

Basic Operations

Power On / Off

Press the [\Box] button on the unit to turn the unit on. The buttons on the front of the unit light up and the current mode status appears in the LCD. Press and hold the [\Box] knob to power off the unit.

Volume Adjustment

To increase or decrease the volume level, push the [VOL +/-] buttons on the front panel. The volume ranges are from "0" to "32". The LCD screen displays the volume level for 5 seconds.

Mute

Press [🖸] button to mute the volume from the unit. Press again to restore the volume. [🐔] is displayed on the LCD. Adjusting the volume or using any of the audio setup features cancels the mute function.

Press the [\square] button on the front panel to display the playing source menu. The playing mode is displayed on the screen.

- 6. On/Off daylight saving time.

- On/Off handbrake; If On, it will remind user not to watch the video or input keypad in the driving process due to safety.
- 14. On/Off the illumination control; If open, the screen backlight automatically becomes dimming when user turns on the vehicle light.
- 15. Steering Wheel control (see next page for setting)
- 16. Touch of to lock, and you need to enter password again for the second time setting.

Steering wheel control

SWC settings

- 1. Before starting press Calibrate.
- 2. Then press YES to reset the preset setting
- 3. Select the function key, then press the phisically key on steering wheel.
- 4. Repeat the sequence until the available functions are completed.
- 5. At the end of the sequence, press Confirm to store the selected functions.



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Audio settings

Audio

- 1. On/Off beep, one touch one beep.
- 2. On/Off loudness effect.
- 3. Subwoover volume level.
- 4. Subwoofer frequency cutting (low pass) 80Hz - 120Hz - 160Hz

Volume

- Adjust the volume of multimedia (music, video and radio).

Bluetooth settings

Bluetooth

- 1. To turn On or Off "Bluetooth" function.
- 2. To turn On or Off "Auto connect" function.
- To turn On or Off "Auto answer" function. If setting to On, the incoming call will be received automatically.
- On/Off automatic download phonebook; if On, the product will automatically download phonebook from mobile phone when Bluetooth connection is done.
- Note: (need permission of mobile phone).
- 5. Touch to modify the product name.



Radio settings

Seek quality

1. When the scan quality is set to -5, the stop sensitivity will be greater (more stations received).

When the scan quality is set to +5, the stop sensitivity will be lower (fewer received stations).

2. Touch to recover to default stop sensitivity.

Region

 Touch to select the region. Changing settings causes loss of previously set settings.

RDS

RDS transmits data to the radio which displays information such as name station, song artist, and song title. RDS service availability varies with areas.

- 4. To turn on or off "RDS" function.
- 5. To turn on or off "AF" function.
- 6. To turn on or off "TA" function.





Radio playback music

Play music

- 1. Select the Radio source to play music.
- Touch(FM-AM)to alternate switch between FM and AM.
- Touch (►) or (►) to automatic search the radio station.
- Touch (<) or (▷) to manually search the radio station.

- 6. Touch (\blacksquare) to select the station in the list.
- 7. Sliding the cursor left or right to rough adjust radio frequency.
- 8. Touch ($\ensuremath{^{\rm Q}}$) to automatic search and save station.
- 9. Radio frequency and Programme Service information.

Press the (PS) to view the collected stations.

Collect station

- 10. Collected favorite station
- 11. Touch (♥) to collect the current station.
- 12. Touch (PS) to back to the radio window.
- 13. Touch (Playing) to back to the radio window.
- 14. Touch (FM) to view the collected FM stations.
- 15. Touch (AM) to view the collected AM stations.
- 16. Touch (Favorite) to view the favorite FM stations.
- 17. Touch (Home) to back to the home page.





Car Play

Using Apple lightning cable to connect iPhone with the product, and it will automatically show the CarPlay interface. User could directly operate the common functions of iPhone on the product. iPhone support: minimum iPhone5; Required iOS: minimum iOS 7.1.

Play with CarPlay

1. Select the CarPlay source to play music.

Play Music

Touch the main interface of CarPlay mode to access all of your content from iTunes.

Call Out / Receive Call

Touch the Phone of CarPlay mode for Calling.

Use Map

Touch the Map of CarPlay mode to let the iPhone show you the way.

Touch the Messages of CarPlay mode for sending message or check unread message.

Siri

- Touch and hold Apple Home key on product or iPhone for using Siri voice assistant, such as issuing a call, playing music, opening the map and other voice commands.

- 3. When iPhone is connected, enable Siri by steering wheel control

Bluetooth mode

You can make or receive phone calls with Bluetooth-enabled phones through the unit. You can also listen to music from a Bluetooth-enabled device.

Search Bluetooth device

Please make sure that the device you desire to connect has been turned on and allowed to be detected. Using a mobile device to search the product, the name will be displayed on your mobile device, or touch (Q search) to search the surrounding Bluetooth devices.

All the devices searched will be displayed on the screen.

Tip:

• The operational range between this unit and a Bluetooth device is approximately 5 meters.

Pairing device

In the mobile device, touch name of the product or choose device on product to connect, and then wait for the connection.

Automatic Connection

If the connected device is out of the operating range, the Bluetooth connection will be disconnected automatically. If user does not close the Bluetooth function, the Bluetooth is automatically reconnected when the device returns to the operating range in few minutes.

Download Phone book

Touch (Download) to download phone book from mobile device, at this time it will show the download tips on the screen of mobile device, touch OK for download, touch Cancel for not download.

Call Out / Receive call

- 1. Dial the phone number for calling.
- 2. Select a name from the phone book to call.
- 3. Choose a record in the call history for calling.
- 4. When call is coming in, choose receiving or hanging up.

Hands-free mode and Private mode

During a call, touch (*) and (\blacksquare) to switch between Hands-free mode and private mode. Touch (\cancel{V}) to mute microphone so that the receiver cannot hear from your side.

Disconnection

- 1. Touch the connected device name for disconnection.
- 2. Touch the dustbin next to the device name to disconnect.
- 3. End the connection directly on the mobile device.

When the machine fails

Machine/function	Phenomena	Solutions
Machine	Cannot power on/off	Check the connection, if it is broken, try to reconnect it; Check the main fuse, if it is damaged, replace it; Press reset key.
	No sound	Adjust the volume. Confirm whether the music and video is supported or not.
Reversing	Abnormal picture	Exit reversing mode and enter again. Check whether the camera is covered by foreign matters. Check whether the type of reverse camera is matched or not. Check the reversing signal cable.
Radio	Noisy; Cannot search the station	Ensure there is no metal products around the machine. Driving the vehicle to the place where the radio signal is good and search the station. If the solutions above are invalid, please check whether the antenna is disconnected, damaged, etc.
Navigation	Satellite positioning failure	Please make sure that the SD card has been inserted into the machine, which has navigation map software inside. Driving the vehicle to the open place and search the satellite, the result will be different due to weather conditions.
Bluetooth	Connecting fail	Please make sure that the Bluetooth of mobile device is turned on.
USB playing	Playing fail	Ensure the U disk is not damaged. Please make sure that the format of content is supported.
